One of the planning recommendations for the City of Washington/East Washington's is to establish a formal, centralized economic development corporation or council focused on the City development and programming efforts. The Greater Altoona Economic Development Corporation (GAEDC) offers a similar model to reference.

GAEDC was formed in 1985 and is now a function of the Altoona Blair County Development Corporation (ABCD).GAEDC continues to focus its core services and programs within the City of Altoona proper, while ABCD Corporation serves all of Blair County. In recent years GAEDC has been instrumental in facilitating new development partnerships with Penn State Altoona that has resulted in several new university functions being housed in renovated buildings within Altoona's central business district. These projects were made possible through financial programs administered through GAEDC and ABCD Corporation.

GADEC further supports specialized programming and special events in the downtown such as the Christmas parade, Jazz Nights and special outdoor evening movie viewing during the summer months. Its purpose shall be to assist in the development of projects, undertakings, studies, and other activities in cooperation and in coordination with federal, state and local governmental and civic bodies for the elimination of slums, blight and blighting influences, and to aid, assist and foster the planning, replanning, development, renewal, redevelopment and improvement of business in the Greater Altoona Area, Blair County, Pennsylvania, all for the primary purpose of combating community deterioration and the securing of the growth and development of business concerns, community facilities and other related facilities, services, and conditions, economic and otherwise, conducive to the progress and general welfare of the community, and to that end:
- C) To take, accept, hold and acquire by bequest, devise, gift, purchase, loan, or lease any property, real, personal, or mixed, whether tangible or intangible, without limitation as to amount, or value.
- D) To sell, convey, lease or make loans, grants, or pledges of any such property, or any interest therein, or proceeds therefrom, and to invest and reinvest the principal thereof and receipts therefrom, if any.
- E) To borrow money upon and pledge or mortgage any such property for any purpose for which it is organized, and to secure notes, bonds, or other forms of indebtedness to secure any of its obligations.
- F) To provide loans for the construction, restoration, reconditioning, remodeling or repair of existing structures, in order to prevent the recurrence of economically and socially disastrous conditions.

- G) To encourage and assist in the preparation of plans, surveys, studies and recommendations.
- H) To guarantee undertakings, contracts or performances of others.
- I) To encourage citizen participation in economic and community improvements and improvement programs and to disseminate information to the general public concerning the objectives and purposes of the corporation.
- J) To hold, improve by construction or otherwise, develop, clear, prepare, and dispose of real property.
- rehabilitation of structures for the purpose of economic development of the Greater Altoona Area.
- L) To carry on any of the foregoing activities or purposes either directly, or as agent for or with other persons, associations, or corporations.

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RESOLUTION

AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Greater Altoona Economic Development Corporation that the Articles of Incorporation filed with the State of Pennsylvania, on the 24th day of April, 1985, be amended to contain language as follows:

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors/
Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment
of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of
the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the
corporation in such manner, or to such organization(s) organized
and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious,
or scientific purposes as at the time shall qualify as an exempt
organization(s) under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue
Code (or the corresponding provisions of any United States Internal
Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors/Trustees shall determine.
Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court
of Common Pleas of the County in which the principal office of the
corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to
such organization(s), as said Court shall determine, which are
organized and operated exclusively for such pruposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby RESOLVED this 26th day of January, 1987, that the Board of Directors of the Greater Altoona Economic Development Corporation hereby adopts the foregoing amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation. The official Articles of Incorporation shall be amended accordingly and dated this 26th date of January as amended copy.
